MINUTES OF THE PARISH MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 13 MARCH 2018

1 Apologies: Lynne Quinton, away on holiday.

2 Minutes of the Meeting held on 09 January 2018.

The minutes of the meeting held on 09 January 2018 having been circulated were taken as a true record approved and signed by the Chairman.

3 Declaration of Interest – To receive Declarations of Interest in accordance with the Code of Conduct and to receive requests for dispensation: There we none.

4 Outstanding Matters: from previous minutes not itemised separately:

- Clerk: **NC** in discussions with potential candidate this week. **NC** to confirm once there is more concrete news.
- Village Hall Wi-Fi: Village hall committee have arranged for a letterbox to be installed allowing a postcode to be issued. Next steps are for the committee to apply to BT for Wi-Fi.

5 Planning: **NC** updated the committee with the latest developments surrounding the issue raised with Johathan James and the plans regarding the multi games area. **NC** advised committee of the revised plans for games area. **NC** advised Johathan James confident planning will go through by end of April. Area of concern surrounds the cutting of the grass in the recreation ground. **NC** to investigate with Scofell whether grass cutting contract is for a year or if **NC** can negotiate a 3 month contract.

NC advised there were three planning applications received.

6 Parish Steward: Cllr Campbell advised council of the following:

Railings on the bridge: no change, painting still scheduled for the spring.

Stockage around tree: work to commence in the spring, parish council to provide materials Wiltshire Council to carry out the work. **SC** to investigate whether Wiltshire Council will supply the material and charge back to the Parish council.

BT Manhole cover on B4192: **SC** still chasing BT to fix.

Stop sign at the bottom junction of Stag Hill has been put back and clean but no new sign. **SC** advised the committee currently no new sign budget, painting of the stop markings on the road to be carried out at the same time.

SC advised next parish steward visit is 5th April 18.

7 Report back from CATG: Littlecote – new signs on the corner of B4192 and Littlecote Road, raise CAGT meeting. Attended by **NC** and **SC** requested new sign and rumble strip, CAGT have agreed to carry out the work.

Ermin street through Bayden closed daylight hours 19.03.18 – 13.04.18– traffic will be divered through Chilton Foliagt between the hours of 9.30 – 15.30.

8 Current Finances: **NC** informed of a correction, Cllr Campbell £17.80 expenses for driving to CAGT meeting.
