MINUTES OF AN EMERGENCY MEETING,
THURSDAY 21ST JUNE 2018 at 7.30 pm, 9, The Groves, Chilton Foliat.

Attending: Cllr. Nic Coome, Cllr. Jim Hynes, Cllr. Steve Campbell, Cllr. Paul Outridge, Cllr. Lynne Quinton, Cllr. Sian Stokoe, Cllr. Rachel Nussey, Ann McMath (Minutes).

Meeting commenced 19.30hrs

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting

1. Apologies: none, full attendance
2. Nic thanked everyone for attending the meeting called to discuss the recreation ground grass cut agreement. The last discussion (approximately 3 months ago) concluded that, with the imminent start of building work on the rec, the PC could not sign up for a grasscut agreement. Nic reported that circumstances have changed. The original planning application has lapsed and, having spoken to the developers and land agent, the new planning application is underway. He understands that it is most unlikely that building work will commence before September 2018.

The PC discussed the need to have the grass cut over the summer, especially as school holidays are approaching. Quotations have been sought from contractors. One quote has been received. Scofell have quoted for a fortnightly grasscut and 3 strimming visits between now and September for £1080.00+ VAT. Nic has worked this out to be a pro rata cost at last year's rate. Nic proposed that the PC accept this quotation and enter into a contract for this season. This was seconded by Jim. All in Agreement. The Clerk is to contact Scofell to confirm and arrange work as soon as possible.

3. Matters Arising

Nic gave a quick update on the current situation with the development on the rec and the Section 106 proposals. He has contacted WALC and NALC for advice regarding legal matters. There was discussion as around where to seek any further advice. Nic outlined the next stages for the proposed contract. He will look at this in detail and will circulate all information pertaining to the recreation ground to councillors for comments. Nic will then contact WALC and NALC.

Lynne reported that the Village Hall Committee will pay the outstanding invoice for the Defibrillator.
