Minutes of an additional Meeting of Chilton Foliat Parish Council
FRIDAY 19TH MARCH 2021, 8pm via Skype

On 4th April 2020, the Government introduced The Local Authorities and Police and Crime Panels (Coronavirus) (Flexibility of Local Authority and Police and Crime Panel Meetings) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020 which allows local councils to meet remotely. These regulations apply to meetings held before 7th May 2021.

- 1 Apologies for absence - none received.
- 2 Council considered the purchase of a Speed Indication Device (SID) to be sited at the west end of the village on the B4192. It was noted that the existing SID on Stag Hill was installed nearly 2 years ago and is reliable, there have been no issues reported. On this basis Cllr. Coome proposed to go ahead with the purchase of SID from ElanCity UK at a cost of £1900.09 + VAT, seconded by Cllr. Hynes, unanimously agreed.

It was agreed to accept the quotation from Id Verde for a total of £455.92 + VAT for the installation of the pole and work to site. Installation of the device and solar panel to be undertaken by Cllr. Campbell and Cllr. Hynes. Proposed by Cllr. Campbell, seconded by Cllr. Quinton, unanimously agreed.

- 3 It was unanimously agreed to name the new road on the recreation ground development as Popham Close, proposed by Cllr. Quinton, seconded by Cllr. Hynes.
